Location:

Käkkälö cabin is located by the river Käkkälö to the south-west direction of Vuontisjärvi village. There is an island in the middle of the river.

Description:

There is one cabin for 6 persons and there is also a separate sauna room. In the yard you can put up some tents.

In the cabin you have a small fireplace, gas-range cooker and a small table. In the kitchen there are some kitchen utensils for your use. In the evenings you can use candles for lighting. Sauna can take 3-4 persons at a time to have a bath. There is a toilet outside and a store to keep the firewood.

In the surroundings you can find some swamp land, forests, lakes, river Käkkälö and a small hill called Ahovaara. Fishing licence you can buy at the Vuontisjärvi village shop. In the late summer and early autumn you can pick berries, like cloudberries as much as you want.

Coming to Käkkälö:

If you drive to east from Hetta (road 956), to direction Vuontisjärvi village which is 20 km away. After about 17 km drive from Hetta there is a narrow forest road to the right. After a drive of 5 km you land to a parking area, and from there you take a path to the cottage – the walk is less than 1 km.

There is a post bus connection daily from Rovaniemi to Hetta and the bus continues to Vuontisjärvi, Peltovuomaa and Nunnanen. In summer time you have to walk 7 km along the forest road to the cabin. In winter you can ski 5-7 km depending on which direction you come from.
